When we run the new report for a dashboard that contains multiple tabs, Workday displays separate usage statistics on how many times users view: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All tabs.</li><li>• Each individual tab.</li></ul> When we only want statistics on how many times users view a specific tab on a dashboard, we can run the report for that specific dashboard tab.  Workday also delivers new report fields on the Dashboard Run History business object (secured to the Custom Report Administration domain) that we can use in the Dashboard Run History report: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dashboard</li><li>• Dashboard Name</li><li>• Dashboard Owner</li><li>• Requested By</li><li>• Requested By User</li><li>• Start Date and Time</li></ul> We can also use the report fields in custom reports.
